## Workshop Options

- Musicianship** with Tim Malcolm, worship leader for many years, and development worker with Tearfund.

In many churches the use of instruments other than the organ is becoming more commonplace and the worship group have a major responsibility in the way they assist the congregation in engaging in worship to Almighty God. This session will focus on working as a group of musicians to bring both quality to the music as well as the focus upon leading people in worship. As part of this, time will be spent with the P.A. group looking at how good quality technical support can enhance the worship and therefore be seen as an integral part of the band.

- Video** with Paul Windo & the Urban Saints Media Team – Paul is Media Co-ordinator for Urban Saints.

We live in a visual age and the use of video is being increasingly recognised as an important media within our churches. This workshop will look at how you can make videos that are relevant to the needs of a particular service at a particular time. This will be a hands-on opportunity to learn about this important aspect of worship.

- P.A.** with Andy Pullinger, who runs his own P.A. & Lighting Company working with both churches and secular organisations.

With the increased role of worship bands within churches, P.A. and the technician has become crucial in that process. We want to help people to bring not only their enthusiasm but the highest possible skill level to supporting the worship. There'll be time looking at equipment and how it is used, as well as time with the Musicianship workshop looking at how the two areas come together effectively.
